- Please, tell us beforehand if you need any assistance

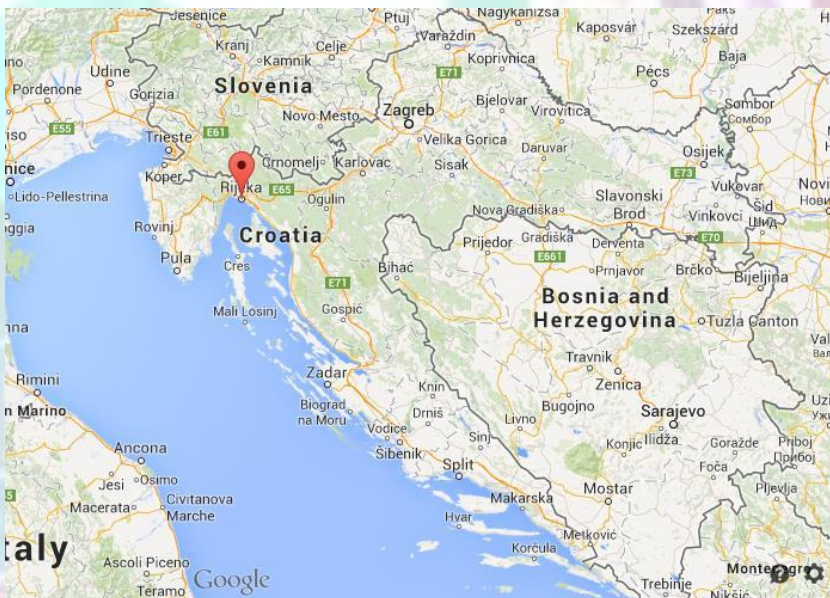
WHERE WILL WE STAY?

Rijeka is the principal seaport and the third-largest city in croatia (after zagreb and split). It is located on kvarner bay, an inlet of the adriatic sea and has a population of 130 000 inhabitants.

Today cca 85% of population are croats, the rest are members of all 22 of croatia's official national minorities are resident in the city. In march 2016, rijeka was selected as the european capital of culture for 2020, and the title of its programme is 'port of diversity'.
